The Adult Education Centre Ozanam Street will be delivering a short introductory course covering the use of email and the internet, from August 30th to September 10th 2010. Participants will receive a total of 6 hours hands-on tuition over the course of one week; this will be 2 hours on a Monday, 2 hours on a Wednesday and 2 hours on a Friday. This course will be free of charge to all participants.

To available of this course you must;

1. have little knowledge or experience of email and internet

AND

2. be a member of one of the following target groups;
 - Older people (defined as aged 55 or over)
 - People who have had less formal education or who have no formal qualifications
 - Unemployed people
 - People experiencing disadvantage – which may include: - people with disabilities, those living alone – particularly in rural areas, single parents, travellers, ex-prisoners, immigrants.
